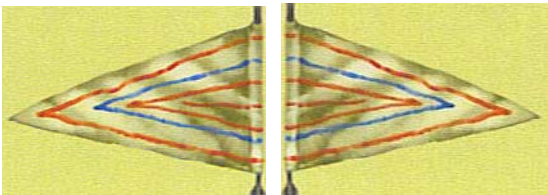

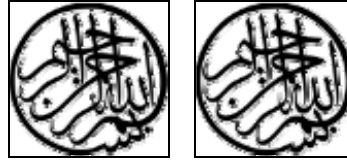

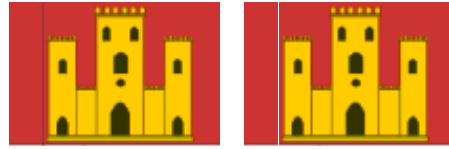


Flag of Ayyubids – Saladin's family dynasty

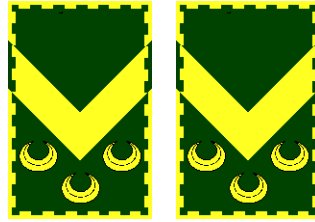


Christian Banner (13th century – El Cid Book)
